PIONEER CERTIFICATE

Adair County Anquestors will issue Pioneer certificates to direct descendants of early settlers living in Adair County, Iowa in 1856 or earlier. Proof of direct descendancy must be submitted.

ELIGILBILITY: To qualify for an Adair County Pioneer Certificate, an applicant must submit documented evidence of direct descendancy from an ancestor who lived in Adair County, Iowa in 1856 or earlier.

An applicant need not be a resident of Adair County, Iowa, nor have ever lived in Adair County. Anyone who is a direct descendant of a person who did reside in Adair County in 1856 or earlier may apply for a Pioneer Certificate from Adair County, Iowa. After proof of direct descent has been submitted and eligibility has been determined, the certificate will be given or mailed. For each ancestor for which an application and documented evidence qualifies, a separate certificate will be issued. If an applicant wants additional certificates for one pioneer ancestors, proof of descent need only be submitted once. Cost for each certificate is \$5.00. This covers postage and handling. When more than one certificate is issued, all certificates will be mailed to one address.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Complete the application as completely as you can.
- 2. Complete the pedigree chart using maiden names when applicable. If you are unsure of any dates or information, place a question mark after the date.
- 3. Submit documented evidence with the application. Examples of documented evidence may be census records; birth, marriage or death records; school or church records; Bible records; military records; obituaries; estate records; land records, headstone inscriptions (giving the location of the cemetery); county histories, etc. **DO NOT SEND ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.** All applications and accompanying verifying material will become the property of Adair County Anquestors. Only one proof selected from the above is necessary but more may be submitted.
- 4. The application form and proof of residency should be submitted to Adair County Anquestors, % Greenfield Public Library, P. O. Box 328, Greenfield, Iowa 50849. Include a check payable to Adair County Anquestors for the cost of the certificate or certificates.
