Reading

Reading develops
vocabulary and
comprehension and
starts a positive
relationship with reading.

Singing

Singing builds vocabulary and slows down language so, children can understand.

Playing

Play helps put thoughts into words as they talk about what they are doing.

These practices can help grown-ups give children a great start to their literacy journeys.

Talking

Children learn language by listening and joining in conversations. Talk to your child often!

Writing

As children see printed letters, they build awareness that print has meaning.
